Proposed new entrance

As part of the Government's Priority School Building Programme, we are seeking permission from the Council to redevelop part of Claverham Community College. The proposals include demolishing the original college building and some of its later extensions.

The planned replacement high-quality building will transform the learning environment for all students and staff, enable the school to make significant savings on running costs and continue to provide a range of community uses of their facilities.



Public Exhibition

We are holding a public exhibition where you can review and comment on the plans before we submit our planning application. The exhibition is in the main hall at Claverham Community College, North Trade Road, Battle, East Sussex, TN33 0HT on **Wednesday 3rd July 2019 3.30pm-8pm.**



Construction information

Temporary accommodation will be provided on site to allow uninterrupted teaching while work is carried out. Traffic and Construction Management Plans will ensure that the school is able to operate safely. Progress updates will be shared with neighbours and the school community. There will be a dedicated contact telephone line for community use.
