Dear Parents and Carers,

Calendar Events during Term 6

We are writing to inform you of some of the arrangements for the remainder of the final term of this most unusual of school years. Obviously, we are having to make some adjustments given the announcements made yesterday evening and will update you in the next few days with any changes to our planned events.

We bade a fond farewell to our current Year 11 students on Friday 28th May following our traditional 'Dress-Up Day' celebration. The vast majority of the year group have conducted themselves with maturity and self discipline since the College re-opened fully in March. Following the Government decision to cancel the summer examination series, we have used this time to collect further evidence required to supplement the information which has been used to determine Teacher Assessed Grades. This has placed a great many demands on the students and they have responded magnificently. I would also like to thank the teaching and support staff for the calm and assured way that they have discharged their duties throughout this process. The deadline for submitting the Teacher Assessed Grades is Friday 18th June and results day will take place on Thursday 12th August.

College Examinations

The College examinations will take place between Tuesday 29th June and Thursday 8th July. These tests will involve every Year group. College examinations take place during Term 6 every year and we report the outcomes to parents at the end of the academic year. We believe that the performance of our students in these tests will play a crucial role in identifying areas of the curriculum which have not been fully understood during the periods of lockdown and remote learning over the last 12 months.

Parents and students will be provided with a schedule of the examinations in the near future. Students will be informed of the topics which they should revise and will, in most cases, cover some of this revision in class prior to the examination period.
