Start of Term 3 - January 2021

In light of the Government's announcement yesterday evening, I am writing with further detail regarding the start to school in January and the key dates for each year group.

The table below indicates when each year group will be in school from the week beginning 4th January. Please note that no students will be in school on Monday, as indicated in the email sent out earlier today.

For students who are remote learning, work will be placed in their Google classroom for each subject area, starting on Tuesday 5th January. Further information regarding the remote learning protocols and what parents, carers and students should expect will be shared with you prior to the beginning of term.

If you are a key worker (as defined by the Government), your child has an EHCP or is looked after, there will be provision on site for them from Tuesday 5th January. Students accessing this provision will be following the same remote learning provision as the rest of their year group, but will be supervised by staff from the College. If you are eligible and require access to this provision please complete the attached form by clicking [here](#). This must be completed by midday on 2nd January 2021.

Regarding the announcement made last night, of which we had no prior knowledge, it is likely that there will be significant work needed in order to begin testing a large number of students and staff in school next term. We will be sharing more information on this as soon as we are able to.
